Attend a WILDLIFE PROGRAM where knowledgeable staff and volunteers share interesting facts about the many creatures found in our area.

Interested in HISTORY? The farm is steeped in a rich history including farming, horticulture and life in the early 1900s.

Learn about the sustainable forestry and the land conservation efforts of The Society for the Protection of NH Forests, our Trees for Troops program, maple syrup making and more.

The Rocks is located on Route 302 in Bethlehem, NH. For more information on any of our programs please contact **Nigel Manley** at (603) 444-6228.

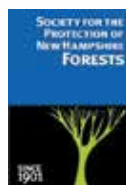
#### Directions to The Rocks:
