THE MAPLE SUGARING TOUR

The Rocks offers a unique, **HANDS-ON** and customizable Maple Tour during sugaring season—from early March through mid-April. Guests will learn the history of maple sugaring, from the times of Native Americans to present day. This informative presentation, held in our Education Center, demonstrates how to tap a maple tree, as well as how the sap is collected and processed using the traditional method of boiling. Participants are then treated to a taste of the warm syrup (with sour pickles to cut the sweetness), made onsite at The Rocks.

Directions to The Rocks:

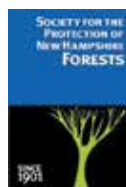
- From North or South, take I-93 to exit 40.
